FREE PARKING: We will have two free off-site parking lots available for use Friday evening and all day and night Saturday from UAB Express 1 Parking – located at 608 8th Street South directly across University Boulevard and from UAB parking lot 15R on 10th Avenue South next to the Epic School parking lot. Free Shuttle buses will run from both parking lots Friday evening from 5:00 pm – 9:00 pm and Saturday from 10:00 am – 9:00 pm.
